

PURCHASING A TICKET

You can purchase Lotto tickets starting at 4:30 am, Monday through Saturday, and 8:00 am on Sundays. Lotto tickets are sold until 11:59 pm daily, except on Wednesday and Saturday when sales are suspended at 7:30 pm, then resume after the draw break until 11:59 pm. Be sure to check the numbers on your ticket for accuracy. You can correct or cancel your ticket within one hour of purchase during retailers' normal business hours (while system is operating) only at the same place you bought the ticket.

You must be 18 or older to purchase tickets. Tickets may be given as gifts to persons of any age, and they may win. All prize claims are subject to validation, rules and regulations of the Colorado Lottery. Sign the back of the ticket because Lotto tickets are bearer instruments. Federal and State tax withholding laws apply to all Lotto winnings over \$5,000. Current tax withholding is 25% Federal and 4% State for a total of 29%. Social Security Number required for payment of prizes \$600 or more to U.S. citizens.

HOW TO PLAY LOTTO

Lotto is Colorado's original jackpot game and to date, there have been more than 370 Lotto jackpot winners. The cost per ticket is \$1. To play Lotto, select your six lucky numbers or you can choose a Quick Pick. You can also select Advance Play and purchase up to 13 weeks of play in advance. Jackpots start at \$1 million and increase until there is a winner. Lotto drawings are held Wednesday and Saturday nights at 7:36 pm.

1. Quick Pick method: Ask any Lotto retailer for a Quick Pick. The Lottery terminal will randomly pick six numbers for the next drawing. You may also ask for Advance Play Quick Picks for up to 26 consecutive drawings. Each line of play costs \$1.
2. Traditional method: Pick up a playslip. Mark your 6 lucky numbers between 1 and 42.
 - You can play up to 10 boards on the same playslip. Each board costs \$1.
 - Mark the Advance Play box to play up to 26 consecutive drawings. Advance play applies to all boards marked on the playslip.
 - Hand your playslip to the clerk to receive your Lotto ticket.

HOW DO I WIN?

Lotto prizes are awarded for matching 3, 4, 5 or 6 numbers. You may begin claiming winning tickets the morning following the drawing.

ODDS OF WINNING

Match	% of Prize Pool	Odds
6 of 6	29.5%	1 in 5,245,786
5 of 6	2%	1 in 24,287
4 of 6	7.5%	1 in 556
3 of 6	10%	1 in 37

Overall odds of winning are 1 in 35. Prizes equal 50% of sales overall.

HOW DO I FIND OUT IF I'VE WON?

- Ask any Lotto retailer for the Winning Numbers Report for the draw date of your ticket.
- Visit us at coloradolottery.com.
- Sign up for text or e-mail notifications at our Web site

when you become a MyLottery member.

- Most local newspapers print winning Lotto numbers the day after the drawing.

HOW TO CLAIM YOUR PRIZE

Immediately sign the back of your ticket. To claim prizes up to \$150, present your ticket at any Lotto retailer within 180 days of the winning drawing. Some Lotto retailers pay prizes up to \$599. Check with your local Lotto retailer for its limit. Prizes of any value can be claimed at Lottery offices in Pueblo, Denver, Grand Junction and Fort Collins (see back for addresses). Tickets can also be claimed by sending the signed ticket with your name and address to the Colorado Lottery, P.O. Box 7, Pueblo, CO 81002-0007 for payment by mail.

Players who match all 6 numbers in any Lotto drawing win all or a share of the Lotto jackpot. If more than one player matches all 6 numbers, the jackpot is shared equally. Players who match 3, 4 and 5 numbers also win a prize based on the sales for the drawing and the number of winners at each level. Prizes must be claimed no later than 180 days after the day of the drawing for which the ticket was purchased.

WHAT CAN I WIN?

The Lotto jackpot keeps growing until there is a winner. Prizes are awarded for matching 3, 4, 5 or 6 numbers. Jackpot winners have the option of choosing Cash Value, which equals approximately 50% of the annuity value and is paid in one lump sum, or the Annuity option, which is paid in 25 annual installments. The first annuity payment is 2.5% of the jackpot share. Following payments increase 3.7% each year until the entire amount is paid.

WHEN YOU PLAY, COLORADO WINS

To date, more than \$2 billion has been allocated to the Conservation Trust Fund for local parks and recreation; the Colorado Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation for state parks and recreation; the Capital Construction Fund for public facilities; and the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund for parks, recreation, wildlife and open space.
